The following information will help you prepare for your puppies' arrival.

Pre-Whelping

| 12 Hours Prior | Mucous Vaginal Discharge May Develop |
| 1-2 Hours Prior | Vaginal Discharge May Become Greenish/Black |

Whelping:

- If obvious contractions occur for longer than 60-90 minutes without passing the first puppy, or longer than 60 minutes between puppies, please call your vet immediately.
- If a bitch successfully free whelps, we recommend doing a follow-up examination of her and the puppies the next day.
- Puppy dewclaw removal and tail amputations (if needed) are performed at day 3.

Recommendations:

- Weigh the puppies three times a day, prior to feeding. Use a kitchen scale that measures in grams and record the puppies' weights. Call your vet if the weights are not increasing daily.
- Monitor the puppies bowel movements.
- Monitor the bitch's mammary glands for adequate milk productions, abnormal swelling or discharge.
- During weaning, do not decrease the bitch's food; this will NOT "dry her up" and only leads to malnourishment.
